MENGWI AND TANAH LOT *A Bali Cultural & Scenic Day Tour*

TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

SANGEH MONKEY FOREST – THE SACRED NUTMEG FOREST



Begin your journey with a visit to Sangeh Monkey Forest, a serene sanctuary where hundreds of long-tailed macaques roam freely amid a 14-hectare forest of towering nutmeg trees. Stroll along tranquil pathways, observe the playful monkeys, and admire the centuries-old Bukit Sari Temple hidden deep within the forest.

TAMAN AYUN ROYAL TEMPLE – THE GARDEN OF HEAVEN



Continue to Taman Ayun, a 17th-century royal temple and UNESCO-listed cultural heritage site. Explore manicured gardens and lotus ponds, and marvel at the multi-tiered Meru shrines symbolizing sacred Mount Mahameru. Your guide will share fascinating insights into Balinese Hindu traditions and the history of the Mengwi Kingdom.

TANAH LOT SEA TEMPLE – BALI'S ICONIC SUNSET LANDMARK



Conclude the day at the world-famous Tanah Lot Temple, dramatically perched on a rocky outcrop in the Indian Ocean. Capture stunning views of the temple surrounded by waves, explore the local art market, and soak in the mystical coastal atmosphere that has made Tanah Lot one of Bali's most celebrated landmarks.
